



- Supports workplaces across Scotland to take a leading role in increasing cycling to and at work
- Sets out guiding framework for workplaces to encourage and support more staff to cycle
- The award framework: Facilities, Organisational Policies, Communication & Promotion
- Provides resources, specialist guidance and support through regional service centres
- Over 750 workplaces awarded or working towards accreditation, reaching over 270,000 employees
- In 2022/23 since April over 140 workplaces have already gained the award
- Development Grant Funds open to all workplaces up to £25,000 capital funding available per site, funded by Transport Scotland. Second round due to open this week.





Cycling Friendly Employer Development Fund





- Capital fund
- Provides grants of up to £25,000 per site for improving cycling facilities such as bike racks or changing areas, that will encourage staff to travel by bike.
- Open to all employers, whether public, private or third sector, with workplaces in Scotland
